Uniquely YOU

I will praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are your works, and that my soul knows well. Psalm 139:14

When I was growing up I admired the giftedness of one of my mother's closest friends. Ms Sadie could look at something in a magazine, take your measurements and just make it. She did not need a pattern, just a visual of how it was to look and make it. When the garment was almost completed she would have you try it on to make sure it was a perfect fit for you. If the garment could talk I believe it would quote the very words of Psalm 139:14 because it was fearfully and wonderfully made. Ms Sadie never tried to alter the design to fit her taste or to look like something someone else may have asked her to create. She made each garment to be a perfect fit just for you so that when all was done and she handed it to you, the tag read "especially made for you by..." Whenever someone misuses one of God's creations he is really disagreeing with God as to the purpose of his work. Anyone who treats you as less than the person God created you to be is stepping outside the boundaries of humanity and standing in the same dangerous space as the adversary when he questioned God's sovereignty and rebelled against his divine purpose.

Each of us as God's original design wears an invisible tag that says "especially made for you by my hands." You were made especially for you to be who he created you to be, to fulfill your unique purpose that only you can fulfill. There is no one exactly like you to do what you were designed to do so celebrate your uniqueness and command others to do the same. Praise God for the way he made you and walk in the divine purpose for which he created you.

Never allow anyone to see or treat you as less than what the creator purposed you to be. Don't allow anyone to sabotage your purpose in life or distract you from the path of life you were ordained to walk. Anyone who sees you as anything less than a fearfully and wonderfully work of God does not know the Creator and has no clue as to your worth. The problem is not with you but with the one who has an ego (edging God out) problem. Walking in darkness never affords one the magnificent eyesight of God. See yourself through the eyes of your maker and do not except any view that does not portray what he sees, not even from you.

Remember you are uniquely YOU for a purpose – know it, show it and celebrate yourself - God does. Who knows a creation better than the creator?
